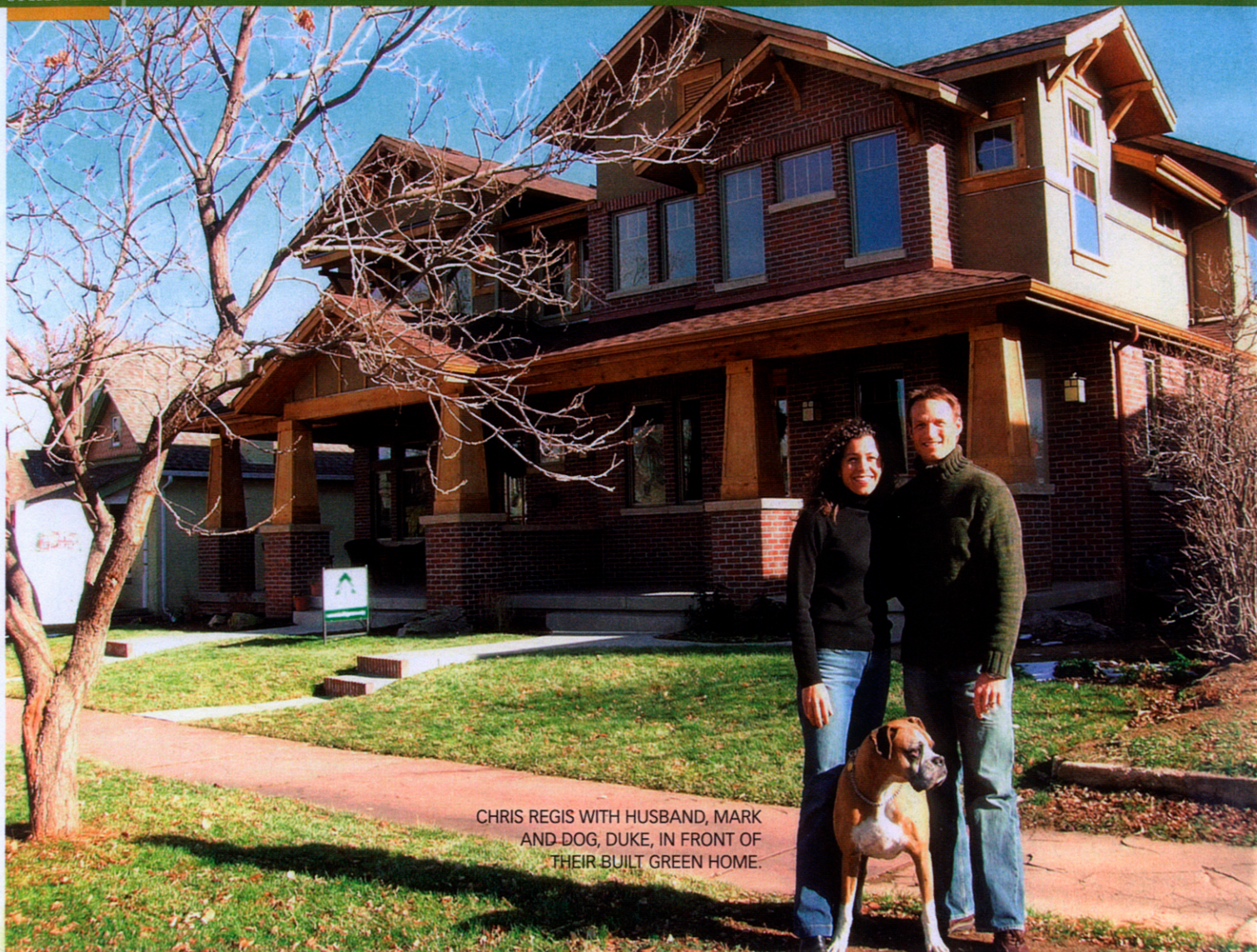
# WINNING:

And that's exactly what she and her company, Domani Homes, Inc. in Denver, did with the Regis residence.

"We incorporated green building into the entire home, from the solar panels to the heating to the paint," Regis says.

Judges added that the Regis residence demonstrated the urban green ethic at its best, with a particular focus on renewable energy, resource conservation and indoor air quality.

The home scored 249 Built Green points and earned an efficiency rating of 40 percent above code.
